## LOOKS LIKE A COLD WINTER IS AHEAD! FUN RECIPES WHEN YOU ARE STUCK INSIDE

### Object art:

You Need: Many varied items such as legos, duplos, bath puffs, corks, cotton balls, apples, kitchen utensils, plungers, carrot tops. Set out some butcher paper, cover a long table and place the paint and objects on the table. Let them explore!

### Ice Cube Painting:

You Need: Ice Cube Trays  
Liquid Watercolor Paint, paper, Popsicle Sticks.  
Fill the ice cube tray 2/3 full of water. Fill the remaining space with the liquid watercolor paint. Freeze. After the ice cubes have frozen, let the kids zoom the colored ice cubes around their paper to make ice tracks! Some kids will want to push the ice with their fingers; some will want to use popsicle sticks.

### Clean Mud:

You Need: Bars of Ivory Soap, old cheese grater, plastic tub, toilet paper, pitcher of water.  
In a sensory tub or dishpan, mix together about 4 bars of grated soap, toilet paper and a pitcher full of water. Squish and squish until it looks like soapy sudsy cool-whip! Dispose of in garbage, NOT down the drain!
